



SUPPLEMENTAL QUESTIONNAIRE Fire Chief



Candidates must submit written answers to each of the following questions with their job application package.

1. Describe your incident command experience. Include specific, detailed examples with description of complexity level. At least one wildland and one structural example must be provided.
2. Describe your experience as an instructor. Include number of classes, type of classes and whether or not the classes involved live fire.
3. Describe your experience with interagency cooperative agreements and providing fire services in a complex mosaic of agencies – local, state and federal.
4. Describe your experience supervising and mentoring others in the fire service. Discuss your philosophy on best supervisory and mentoring practices.
5. Describe your experience with recruiting volunteers, interns and paid staff. Discuss methods you have successfully used.
6. Describe your administrative and budgeting experience.
7. Describe your experience working with the public to reduce community risk and improve education and preparedness.
