## 4000.10 Board of Directors

- **4000.11** <u>Governing Body.</u> The District shall be governed by a five-member Board of Directors, in accordance to California Government Code Sections 61000-61250 (Community Services Districts). Members of the Board of Directors must meet the following criteria:
  - 1. No person shall be a candidate for the Board of Directors unless he or she is a voter of the District.
  - 2. A member of the Board of Directors shall not be the General Manager, the District Treasurer or any other compensated employee of the District.
- **4000.12** <u>Purpose.</u> The Board of Directors is responsible for the overall governance of the District, establishing policies for District operation and appointing a General Manager to implement those policies. All Directors shall exercise their independent judgment on behalf of the interests of the entire District, including the residents, property owners, and the public as a whole.

## 4000.20 Selection of Directors

- 4000.21 <u>Election and Terms.</u> Directors shall be elected at large, serving as follows:
  - 1. Directors shall serve staggered terms of four years.
  - 2. Terms shall begin on the first Friday in December following their election.
- **4000.22** <u>Vacancies.</u> Board of Director vacancies in the middle of a term shall be filled pursuant to Section 1780 of the California Government Code.

## 4000.30 Officers

- **4000.31** <u>Board Officers.</u> The Board of Directors shall elect the following Officers each December to serve in that office for the following calendar year:
  - 1. <u>President.</u> The President of the Board of Directors shall serve as chairperson at all Board meetings. He/she shall have the same rights as the other members of the Board in voting, introducing motions, resolutions and ordinances, and any discussion of questions that follow said actions.
  - 2. <u>Vice President.</u> In the absence of the President, the Vice President of the Board of Directors shall serve as chairperson over all meetings of the Board. If the President and Vice President of the Board are both absent, the remaining members present shall select one of themselves to act as chairperson of the meeting.
- **4000.32** <u>District Officers.</u> The Board of Directors shall appoint the following District Officers to serve at their pleasure:
  - 1. <u>General Manager</u>. The General Manager shall be responsible for all of the following:
    - A. Implementation of the policies established by the Board of Directors for the operation of the District.
    - B. Appointment, supervision, discipline, and dismissal of the District's employees, consistent with employee relations policies and agreements established by the Board of Directors.
    - C. Supervision of the District's facilities and services.
    - D. Supervision of the District's finances.
  - 2. <u>District Treasurer</u>. The Board may appoint the General Manager as the District Treasurer. The District Treasurer shall be responsible for all of the following:
    - A. Implementation of a system of accounting that adheres to generally accepted accounting principles and, at all times, shows the District's financial condition.
    - B. Implementation of the Board's financial policies and laws to control withdrawals and deposits of District funds, make payments, manage loans, pay employee salaries and make other financial transactions required for District operations.
    - C. Providing written reports to the Board of Directors regarding the receipts, disbursements and balances in the accounts controlled by the District Treasurer.
